The following is an excerpt, taken from the book I am getting ready to publish called; “Adventures in the Spiritual Realm. The paragraphs before chapter 1 are taken from the Introduction. These paragraphs explain how I received the night vision. Pray that the Lord will bless you as you read this chapter.

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While I Was Sleeping

All of the chapters in this book have been written while spending time with the Lord, except for the first chapter. The first chapter was given to me while I was sleeping. On the night of April 10, 2011, I experienced something that I had never experienced before. I seemed to have dreamed one continual dream for the entire night. Even though I had gotten up a couple of times, the dream did not stop but continued to play out in my spirit and my mind. I greatly wondered about this because I noticed that it was happening before I had returned to bed. Even though I was half asleep, I wondered if I were actually dreaming or if the Lord had given me a night vision. I knew that I had never experienced anything quite like this before. Even though I didn't understand it, I noticed that it seemed as though I were in two places at once. I was still aware of my natural surroundings, and yet at the same time, I seemed to be simultaneously experiencing another time and place.

The events of this experience seemed to be taking place, during perilous times, sometime in the future. It left such an impression on my spirit that I decided to stop working on the book so that I could concentrate on accurately recording this experience. As soon as I felt that I was finished, I prayed and asked the Lord for direction. At that time, I thought I would submit it to the Body of Christ; but, while I continued to pray about it, I did not feel prompted by the Holy Spirit to do so; although, I did share it with a few close friends and family members. At the time the dream or night vision occurred, I didn't think it was a part of the book because I did not receive it in the same way I had received revelation for the book. But, as time passed, the Holy Spirit began to speak to me about including it. It was then I realized that the night vision seemed to be the reason for my writing the book.

I have continued to meditate on this night vision from time-to-time because of its message. As time passed, I came to believe that it should not be taken literally. Even though disastrous events might occur sometime in the future, I did not witness what had actually occurred. The Lord only let me see and feel what it would be like if one or more major disasters occurred within a short period of time. The night vision has also given me more insight and strategy on how all of us should respond to the events or challenges we face during our lifetime.

CHAPTER 1

THE NIGHT VISION

*The Lord is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble;
And He knows those who trust in Him.
(Nahum 1:7)*

Suddenly, I found myself walking the streets of a big city; although, I was not able to identify the city or its exact location. As I walked among the people on the streets, I sensed that many terrible events had recently occurred, in America. Even though I was not shown any of the details, I felt the impact of what had happened, within me. Somehow, I sensed that other areas of the country had been impacted as well. As I looked around, I could easily see that I was experiencing the same emotions as everyone else. And, what I was experiencing felt so real that I thought that it really was real.

It felt as though the Lord had taken me from my bed and dropped me into another time and place, sometime in the future. As I tried to adjust to my new surroundings, I noticed that I could feel the weight and the severity of what had happened, within me. My spirit felt so heavy that I knew I was feeling the enormity of it all. I sensed that all of these events or disasters had occurred within a relatively short period of time. Instinctively, I knew that some of these events had affected the earth; but, I also sensed that every area of our lives had been impacted, by them, as well.

As I walked among the people, on the streets of the city, it was easy for me to see that everyone was shocked and that no one knew what to do or how to respond. Even though I sensed that these were exceptionally trying times, the Lord did not reveal to me exactly what had happened. But at the same time, I could readily see that what had happened had caused a lot fear and anxiety in everyone I had encountered. Somehow, I knew that thoughts about the uncertainty of the future and thoughts about what each person should do and how they were going to live or survive were bombarding everyone's mind. I could tell by their reaction that everyone was shaken, to the core. And, I could see that most of the people were letting their emotions influence or control how they responded.

The Purpose

Somehow, I understood that my purpose for being here was to observe and record the reactions of various people groups and to observe the strategy of the enemy. Even though I did not hear the Lord directly communicate this to me, I seemed to instinctively know that the Lord had already deposited this assignment within me. As soon as these thoughts came into my mind I decided to stand off to one side of the sidewalk so that it would be easier for me to receive any additional insight or instruction I might need from the Lord.

As I looked at the scene before me, I felt overwhelmed by it all. I found that it was hard for me to think rationally. I knew that my own thinking and all of my emotions had been greatly shaken. Even though a part of my consciousness seemed to know that I did not know how I got to be in this circumstance, I also sensed that there was no way out of this, for me. Instinctively, I knew that I would have to walk through it. Somehow, I understood that I was faced with making the same decisions as everyone else. I knew that I had to decide how I was going to respond to all of this, myself. While I stood there, in shock and disbelief, I found myself being pulled in two very different directions.

I felt shocked and I felt numb as I continued to observe the people around me. I could see that everyone was having trouble controlling their emotions. Shock and disbelief registered on everyone's faces. Fear and anxiety was so prevalent that I knew that it would be easy for everyone to let these emotions influence everything they said or did. I also knew that I could not give in to these emotions; nor, could I let them control me if I were going to be of any help or use to anyone. Yet, I found myself thinking that I, too, did not know how to respond. Feelings of hopelessness and despair seemed to envelop me. I knew that whatever we were facing would be a challenge for even the greatest saint. I had to wonder if I were prepared to handle the challenges I would be facing.

The Choice

All of these thoughts seemed overwhelming, to me. Yet, they continued to bombard my mind while I stood there, watching the people. I could feel the weight of them, within me. The heaviness felt so great that it felt like I was carrying the weight of the world on my shoulders. But, somehow, I still knew what I had to do—I knew that I would have to deliberately choose to follow the Lord regardless of what I might see or have to endure. And, I knew that I could not let these negative emotions control me or consume me. In that moment, I decided to close my eyes so that it would be easier for me to collect my thoughts and focus on the Lord.

As soon as I did this, I began to sense more of the Lord's abiding presence, within me. I could actually feel myself being drawn deeper into His presence; and, at the same time, I sensed that the heaviness I had been feeling was beginning to lift from me. Because of this, I decided to remain in this moment for as long as I could.

It wasn't long before I realized that the weight of these negative emotions could not, in any way, overcome the reality of who I had become after I had accepted the Lord as my Savior. I began to sense that nothing could alter or change what the Lord had already deposited, within me. As I continued to meditate on this truth, I noticed that His presence also reassured me that I had already been positioned, in Him. As I stood there, embracing the truth of it all, His abiding presence continued to grow stronger within me. His presence became so real, to me, that it seemed as though nothing else mattered.

Before long, I began to feel His peace surround me. I knew that I was experiencing the reality of something that is far superior to anything I might encounter in the physical realm. As I continued to remain there, in His presence, I sensed that His peace also brought the reality of all He has given me and has provided for me. I began to realize that I had everything I needed to rise

above every circumstance—and, most importantly, I sensed the abiding presence of the Holy Spirit dwelling on the inside of me.¹ I knew that I could not allow myself to surrender to fear or anxiety. And, it had become clear to me that the Lord is always with me, regardless of what I might experience or see happening all around me. At that moment, I found myself whispering; *“I know that Your mercy and Your grace is sufficient.”*²

As soon as I heard myself whisper those words, I knew that I had resolved, within myself, to trust the Lord. And, I felt confident that He would never leave me. I felt grateful for the Spirit of the Lord, abiding within me. I sensed that He had helped me make this decision. It felt as though a huge weight had been lifted from me. I could feel my spirit awoken to the presence of the Lord. Before long, I felt immersed in Him and in His mighty power.”³ I noticed that I felt so strong, in the Lord, that I felt invincible!

The Equipping

After experiencing Him like this, I knew that the Lord’s power and might is more than able to equip me for every trial. It was then, I noticed that all fear, anxiety and every concern had fled before the awesome presence of the Lord; even though it was easy for me to see that my circumstances had not changed.

While I remained there, I began to feel the presence of the Holy Spirit expand, within me. It felt as though I had been supernaturally strengthened with power from on high. I decided to remain there, in the presence of the Lord, a little while longer. Before long, I began to feel His love as it seemed to well up from deep within me. I felt peaceful now, and I noticed that my mind had become clearer. After spending these few moments with the Lord, I felt confident that I would have the inner strength, I needed, to make the right decisions. At that moment, I knew that regardless of whatever may happen, the Lord would never leave any of us nor would He forsake us.⁴ And, I knew that I would never forget this moment, with the Lord. I felt so secure, in Him, now. And, I felt thankful and grateful for everything He has given to us.

When I opened my eyes, I knew that I had changed. I felt confident and settled. I did not feel like the same person I had been just moments before. I was surprised by just how easy it was for me to refocus my thoughts on the truth of my salvation and on my position in the Lord. Even though I had always known that the possibility of something, like this, might happen one day, I never really imagined that I would ever be in a situation like this. But, after taking the time to seek the Lord, I felt strengthened. I could feel His presence abiding within me. I knew that it had been His strength and confidence I was sensing and not my own. Almost immediately I determined,

within myself, that regardless of what I would see or hear or would have to go through, I would choose to cling to the Lord.

It was then I realized just how easy it is, for us, to abide in the Lord's power and strength. *"It only takes one decision, from us,"* I thought. We need only choose to turn our hearts towards Him and to determine to abide in all that He has given us. At that moment, I realized just how important it is for us to take the time to settle ourselves in the Lord and not impulsively react to what we see or hear all around us. I felt grateful and thankful that the Lord had shown me these things.

Three Distinct Groups of People

While I stood there watching the people, suddenly, I remembered my assignment. I decided to walk among the people on the street so that it would be easier to observe them. But as I walked along, I did not feel like I was able to properly observe them without interacting with them so I decided that I would try to help them or pray with them whenever I could. Once I started doing this, I noticed other Christians had been doing the same thing. I found myself wondering if the Lord had given them a similar assignment, as well.

It wasn't very long before I noticed that the Christians had begun to work together. Even though I sensed that they were from different denominational backgrounds, I didn't see any of them question or discuss each other's beliefs. Everyone had been accepted. It was beautiful to see this kind of unity and acceptance among us. And, it was easy for me to see that some of the things we considered important in the church did not hold the same importance, now. After a short time, I noticed that I could easily define three distinct groupings among the people.

The First Group

The first group did not believe in the Lord at all. I sensed that there are several reasons for this. I knew that some of these people had never even heard of the Lord; while others had known Him some time during their past. This group reacted in much the same way we might expect them to react today. I could see that most of them were angry and visibly shaken. They used negative words to describe their circumstances, or to describe their feelings. I noticed that everything they said was negative.

It wasn't hard for me to see that this had been a way of life for them. They were critical and judgmental of everyone who held any type of leadership position and they continuously harassed and threatened them. I could tell, by what they were saying, that they expected those who held leadership positions to meet all of their needs. I did not see anyone in this group try to help themselves; and, I did not see many of them try to help anyone else.

I also noticed that their words did not contain any hope whatsoever, but instead, their words affirmed everything that had recently happened and everything they had been personally experiencing. I could easily see that this had been a way of life for them for quite some time—even before these disastrous events had occurred. Almost all of the people, within this group, did not seem to have any real sense of truth or reality. Somehow, I sensed that their own hardness of heart had kept them in this place of bondage, and I sensed that it had also kept them from receiving the Lord's love. I watched them as they tried to lie or con others into meeting their needs. Somehow, I

knew that these traits did not just appear; they had been with them for quite some time. Yet, I felt the Lord's love, mercy and compassion rise up within me, for them. I wondered if they could be helped. I didn't know....

The Enemy's Strategy

While I continued to observe some of the people in this first group, the spiritual realm opened before me. Now, I could simultaneously see into the spiritual realm as well as in the natural realm. When I looked around, I saw that several little demons had surrounded each person. I could tell by their appearance that these demons did not have any real power or authority of their own. Because of this, I wondered why they were here; and, I wondered how they would be able to manipulate or control these people. But, as I continued to watch, I noticed that these demons seemed to emit several negative emotions into the atmosphere, around them. I noticed that whenever a person spoke something negative, the demons would emit something that looked like a cloud of these same negative emotions into the atmosphere. I was stunned when I realized that their own words had empowered and enabled the demons to do this. It didn't take long before the atmosphere was permeated with emotions such as; hatred, resentment, anger, fear and anxiety. Even though the people were not consciously aware of the demons, I could readily see that these negative emotions were able to influence their thoughts and behavior. And, I could see that the people naturally accepted all of these emotions as their own.

I was amazed by the simplicity of this strategy. I did not see the demons provoke this group in any way—they simply waited and listened for the people to speak. As soon as a person spoke a negative word, one or more demons would take their words and then run somewhere, with them. Instinctively, I knew that the demons were using each person's words to cause what they had just spoken to come to pass within their own life. I could easily see that each person's thoughts and words were used to bring them into greater bondage and deception. I was astounded as I watched this happen over and over again. I noticed that as soon as a demon would leave, immediately, one or more demons would come to replace the ones who had just left. There seemed to be no end to this. I had to wonder if this had been the enemy's strategy all along. I was amazed by the simplicity of it.

I could easily see that this group was helpless to stop this from occurring; and, I could see that they had nothing to fight with because they did not know the Lord. They had a limited understanding of what was happening, and they did not know what to do or how to react to these things. Because of this, every time they spoke, their own words were used by the demons to reinforce their fears and anxiety and to create havoc within every area of their lives. This added greatly to their plight. I was astounded by this, and I greatly wondered about it and found myself thinking; *"Is the enemy's plan really that simple?"*

My heart went out to these people. I felt filled with the love and compassion of the Lord, for them. Even though the situation looked hopeless, I sensed that some of the people in this group could be helped. *"But how?"* I wondered. Somehow, I knew that the Lord wanted to impart to His people the strategy they needed to help them. My eyes were opened to the truth of the reality of it all. *"We are in a battle,"* I thought. *"A battle for souls."* At that moment, I prayed: *"Lord, open our eyes so that we may clearly see what is really going on all around us. Help us discern between good and evil. Expose*

darkness, wherever it may be found, and show us the strategies of the enemy; not only for these people but also for our country and for other countries of the world, as well. Lord, teach us how to effectively use all of the weapons you have given us—especially our thoughts and our words, so that we may bring freedom to ourselves as well as to those we encounter. I pray this, in the Name of Jesus.”

After I prayed, I felt like the Lord had given me an overwhelming assurance that He has already given us everything we could ever need to be victorious, in every circumstance. This thought was sobering. As I pondered this, I could feel the strength of the truth and reality of it rise up within me. I felt empowered by this truth. I felt the sober reality of the importance of our words. So much so that it seemed to fill every part of my being. At that moment, I knew that He had equipped us and that He had been preparing us for this moment. I knew that all of the answers, we needed, could be found in the Lord and in the Word of God. As soon as I realized this, I felt the power of the Holy Spirit rise up within me. Yet, I still wondered greatly about it all.

The Other Two Groups

It seemed as though I had spent several days in this night vision. Even though I had gotten up a couple of times to go to the bathroom, the vision continued unabated. Because of this, I had plenty of time to observe each group's reactions as I continued to interact with them. It didn't take long before I was able to identify two distinct groups of Christians. It was easy for me to discern the differences between them because each group used different words to describe their situation. It was pretty obvious that one group knew the Scriptures and had previously developed an intimate relationship, with the Lord, while the other group had not done so. I could see that one group seemed to be predominately controlled or motivated by fear and anxiety, while the other group seemed more settled in the peace of the Lord.

Christians Who Did not Know the Lord Very Well

While I observed and interacted with the group of Christians that did not seem to know the Lord very well, I noticed that I could not see much difference between their words and actions and the words and actions of those who did not know the Lord at all. Both groups reacted to their circumstances in much the same way. I could see, just by observing them, they had allowed themselves to be influenced by whatever was happening all around them. Somehow, I knew that they had accepted other negative emotions about themselves, as well. I knew that the people in this group did not have to allow this. They had chosen to react this way even though I sensed that most of them knew enough of the Word of God to choose differently.

I also noticed that these negative emotions obstructed and clouded their thinking and it made it easier for the enemy to deceive them. I could tell that their lack of decision to follow the Lord had made it a lot harder for them to see clearly. Even though I knew that the Holy Spirit still remained with them and wanted to help them through this difficult time, most of them did not seem to be aware of this. As I watched them, I was astounded, when I realized what an impact negative words and emotions can have on us, when we give in to them. I could tell, just by watching them, that they had let their emotions influence or control every area of their life!

The Forfeiture

It was then I realized that these Christians seemed to forfeit much of what the Lord had given them just by giving in to negative thoughts and emotions and letting them control their lives. Somehow, I knew that the Lord did not take what He had given to them away from them. It seemed like they had deprived themselves of these things by speaking and by agreeing with what they were seeing and feeling instead of agreeing with the truth of what had been written within Word of God. What was even worse, they did not seem to know that they were responsible for creating a lot (if not all) of their own problems by doing this. I could easily see that they didn't understand why the Lord was not helping them.

It was then the Holy Spirit opened my eyes to see that little demons had also surrounded this group. While I continued to watch, I could see that the enemy had been observing their lack of faith just by watching how they responded to the events in their life. I watched, as these demons took their words and actions and used them against them. Before long, I noticed that these little demons were following everyone—just waiting for someone to speak something that could be used to wreak havoc within their lives and in the lives of others.

I continued to observe this happen, over and over again. I felt a soberness awaken within me. I knew that if these events were real and if they actually occurred sometime during our life time; once they began, it would be extremely hard for us to prepare ourselves in the midst of them. But, somehow, I felt that it would not be impossible for us to do this. We would still be able to repent and draw from what we had known and accepted of the Word of God, and we would still be able to hear the voice of the Holy Spirit.

It was easy for me to see that if these events or similar events had actually occurred, it would greatly challenge our faith. I knew that we would have to determine to trust the Lord to meet all of our needs as well as trust Him to provide us with direction. Circumstances, like these, would call for an immediate response from us. We would have to quickly determine to strengthen ourselves in the Lord and to walk by faith and not by sight.⁵

As I continued to observe this group, it became obvious, to me, that the kingdom of darkness did not have any real power or authority over any of them. I was surprised to find that the strategy of the enemy was so simple. The little demons just took the words each person spoke, and then, used their own words against them. I could see that this group spoke their own fears or their perceived lack right into existence; even though I sensed that the Lord wanted them to receive what they needed, from Him. While I continued to watch, I also noticed that this group seemed to be carrying the weight of the world on their shoulders; and, they seemed to be carrying all of their past hurts and disappointments they had incurred on their journey through life, as well.

As soon as they spoke, the enemy did not waste any time before using their own words to create havoc within their lives. I was astounded when I realized that it was their own words and

actions that gave these little demons power over them. It was clear, to me, that it did not have to be this way. And, it was easy for me to see that the enemy did not have any real power or authority at all. It seemed as though this truth was emphasized, to me, over and over again. After a short time, some of these Christians realized what they had been doing and repented for doubting the truth of the Word of God. As soon as they did this, they realized that they had allowed the cares of this world and their lack of commitment to rob them of all that the Lord had given them. Now, they were able to use their words to their advantage. At that moment, I realized just how important it is for us to repent for not believing and receiving what the Lord has given us. Somehow, I knew that we would not be able to experience the fullness of our salvation until we do.

Christians Who Walked with the Lord

I noticed that the Christians, who had walked closely with the Lord, behaved much differently. I could tell just by watching them that they were careful to remain in the peace of God. And, I could see that they had developed a deeper relationship with the Lord. Somehow, I knew that they had also received God's love for themselves. I noticed that they seemed to radiate with a confidence that was not their own. Even though things were chaotic around them, they were careful not to react to their circumstances in a negative way.

I could tell, just by observing them, they knew the Lord, and I could see that they had accepted His love for them. I noticed that this group did not seem to be weighted down with the cares of this world like the other two groups; and, they did not seem to be weighted down with the memories of anything that had happened to them some time in their past. I could tell that they had an intimate relationship with the Lord, and they also seemed to have embraced the truth of the Word of God. Even in the midst of these trials, they exuded confidence in the Lord; and, I could see that they were careful to continue to abide in His presence.

While I continued to observe them, I could tell that they trusted in the Lord as soon as I heard them speak. It was easy for me to know that the Holy Spirit is abiding with every one of them—leading them and guiding them, as they prayed about the direction they should take and what they should speak. Because of this, I could see that this group responded to their circumstances by tapping into the great power and authority and unlimited resources of the Kingdom of Heaven. And, somehow, I was able to see that an abundance of the Lord's mercy and grace, resting upon them.

Even though they did not fully understand everything that had happened, around them, and things appeared to be chaotic, they did understand the importance of their words. I noticed that they were very careful not to give the enemy anything to work with. And, they were careful to watch every word that came out of their mouth. Because of this, they did not say anything that could be used against them. They did not agree, in any way, with the other two groups about anything that could be construed as negative. Yet, at the same time, I watched them respond to these other groups with the love and compassion of the Lord. Because of this, they were able to help many of them trust in the Lord, as well.

While I observed them, I noticed that whenever they received answers to their prayers and they saw the manifestation of their declarations, their minds became clearer and they gained more

faith and confidence in the Lord. This confirmation helped them to know and understand their own position in the Lord. I watched as the power and authority operating through them increased, as they continued to step out in faith. What was even more amazing; they began to shine with the light and glory of God! Once they realized this, it greatly encouraged them and empowered them to continue speaking in accordance with the truth of the Word of God. I couldn't help but wonder about it all!

The Power of Agreement

I noticed that after a short time, they began to come together to strategize and to come into agreement with one another. This seemed to be natural, for them, because somehow I knew that the Holy Spirit had already been directing each of them to do this. As soon as they began to work together and come into agreement with one another, the power and authority of their words greatly increased. I also noticed that they were careful to pray and receive direction from the Lord; and they were careful to remain in agreement with the Word of God.

While I observed them, I noticed that if they thought or said anything that might be perceived as contrary to the Word of God, they repented immediately. I watched them as they went through various trials. I noticed that they were concerned about these trials yet it was obvious that these things did not overwhelm them. I knew that they had already chosen to live by the Word of God before these things ever began to happen. I noticed that they consistently prayed about direction and strategy, and they prayed in the Spirit every chance they got.⁶ And, I could see that they were careful to stay close to the Lord and declare the truth of His Word over every circumstance. Somehow, I knew that they had been awakened to the absolute truth of the Scriptures. I could easily see that they understood that they had been redeemed by the blood of the lamb and that they had been bought with a precious price. I knew that they would continue to stand, regardless of what happened. It truly was a glorious sight to see!

Angels on Assignment

It was at that very moment, the Lord opened my eyes to see that hordes of angels had encamped round about His people. Even though the little demons were listening to everything they said; they could not get very close to these Christians because their words, prayers and declarations had actually created a barrier of faith. When I looked, I saw that the atmosphere was charged with the substance of faith. And, this faith had actually created a wall of protection around them.

I watched, as these angels waited for the Christians to speak or pray. As soon a Christian spoke or declared the truth of the Word of God, these angels took their words and used them to create what they had spoken. I could see that these Christians were able to live out of the resources of the Kingdom of God even while living on the earth.

Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all saints.

Somehow, I knew that great mercy and grace had surrounded them. I noticed that the enemy could not penetrate this barrier of grace and truth. It was easy for me to see that these Christians had not given the little demons anything to work with. After seeing this, I knew that the Lord had made it easy for us—we only need to come into agreement with the truth of the Word of God and the inner witness of the Holy Spirit. One thing astounded me, as I observed this group, I never saw anyone fail. The Lord reminded me of a Scripture:

“And they overcame them by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.”

(Revelation 12:11)

I couldn't help but feel amazed by it all!

Summary

As soon as I awakened, I began to record what I had observed. Even though I felt that this dream or night vision was from the Lord, I did not feel that the Lord wanted me to publicly share it at that time. Since then, I have prayed about what I had seen from time-to-time and about the timing of its release. I did not see how it all ended; but, I did see that when we choose to come into agreement with one another, and when we come into agreement with the Word of God and speak forth the truths that have been written in it, for us, we cannot fail.

I realize that the Lord only permitted me to see a portion of what was really taking place in the physical and spiritual realms. I do not know if these events will actually take place sometime in the future or if the Lord showed me these things to illustrate the importance of our choosing how we should respond to them.

After experiencing this dream or night vision, I clearly understood that we have been given everything that we could ever need to live in the limitless power and authority of the Lord, regardless of any circumstance. I could see that many of us have been guilty of agreeing with the enemy against ourselves, against our country and against its leadership. I watched as the Lord's people repented for this. Then, I saw the Holy Spirit take His rightful place within each of us. It was easy for me to see that those who loved the Lord, consciously and deliberately chose to unconditionally follow Him. It was then I realized that the Lord, and His Church, could never be defeated; regardless of what might happen on the earth. It would utterly be impossible!
